*Pastor's
Message*



We can finally put 2020 in the rearview mirror! It was a difficult year for many of us in many different ways. We all had to make adjustments impacting how we relate to other people, including those we are closest to. Many of us have lost people we love or haven't been able to visit with family and friends due to the effects of COVID-19; a virus that is unlike any other we've seen in our lifetime. I think it's safe to say that even with the vaccines that are becoming available that life as we knew it prior to March 2020 will not be the same. Yes, there will come a point when things are under control, but the memories of how the virus changed our world, country, and even our Emmanuel's community will stay with us for years to come.

Having said that we have to remember that as difficult as these past nine months have been, they are in no way a sign that God has abandoned us or is punishing us. Although most of us haven't experienced anything like it there have been multiple times throughout history when major illnesses have devastated various parts of the world including the plagues that swept through Europe, the large number of deaths of Native Americans who were exposed to new diseases after people from Europe came to North America, and the Spanish Flu epidemic of 1918. The important thing for us is to learn from what has previously happened and do whatever we can to keep as many people as possible from being adversely affected.

As Christians we have an obligation to always consider if our actions are putting others at risk and if they are, we are called to act in ways that minimize that risk as much as possible. This may include doing some things we'd rather not do or not doing things we want to do. This mindset goes beyond how we respond to COVID. It comes down to caring for each other and treating people with the respect and compassion we all deserve. Time after time Jesus aligns himself with those who are marginalized or oppressed and unable to care for themselves. As his followers it seems to me that no less is to be expected of us.

Throughout this new year may we always be aware that everything we do should be based on the WE rather than the ME because we are all in this together and that includes God who will never leave us alone.

I pray that all of you will be richly blessed and be a blessing to others.
