Our meetings are the third Monday of the month at 6:30pm. Next meeting is April 19 at 6:30. Everyone is Welcome!







# Alleluia, Sunday School! Jesus Is Risen!



Dear Sunday School Children,

It's hard to believe that it's Spring – the season of renewal and new life! And, the Easter story about Jesus and the empty tomb helps remind us that God is faithful and provides the hope we all need. It's a good message for us as we look forward to an end of pandemic and virus – and we celebrate that life might begin to get back to some normalcy.
