Pastor's Word . . .

from Pastor Paulette Obrecht

Lent is one of the oldest seasons on the Church calendar and originated as a time for preparation for baptism, a time which could be very lengthy. Over time, the season was compacted into forty days and became a time for personal reflection and penitence for all Christians, not only baptismal candidates. The season begins with Ash Wednesday and ends with Easter.



The dates for Ash Wednesday and Easter have been set according to some very complex ecclesiastical (church) rules first developed at the Council of Nicaea in 325 CE. These rules have been revised over the years, particularly in 1582 when Pope Gregory XIII changed the Julian calendar to the Gregorian calendar – the one we still follow today. According to the rules based on this Gregorian calendar, Easter falls on the first Sunday following the first ecclesiastical (not astronomical) full moon that occurs on or after the vernal (Spring) equinox, which is set by the church at March 21 (instead of March 19-21, as the scientists calculate it). Therefore, the earliest date Easter can occur is March 22 and the latest date is April 25.

If you think this is complicated, just remember that the Gregorian calendar also gave us Leap Year Day (February 29), which occurs once every four years, except for years divisible by 100 years – although years divisible by 400 do add the extra day ... oh, never mind.

These time calculations should serve to remind us all that there is human (including eccliastical time) – and there is God's time. God created the universe according to God's time. God is the One who decides when the Day of the Lord is upon us. God is the One who created a season for everything and a time for every matter under heaven – and we (including the church) cannot control these things no matter how much we might try or no matter how sophisticated human knowledge becomes. The only sure thing in our lives is God's time of faithfulness to us – God's gift of grace offered to us through the life, death and resurrection of God's only Son, Jesus Christ.

As we celebrate Ash Wednesday on March 2 – as we begin our Lenten journey – let's take some human time to reflect on the meaning of our baptism into Christ's death and the promise of new life, as we become awash in God's unfailing mercy and forgiveness.

Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love. – Psalm 51:1

Lent Begins on Ash Wednesday March 2, 2022

The Lenten season begins on Ash Wednesday and lasts for 40 days (not including Sundays). The forty days of Lent recall the 40 day fast of Jesus in the wilderness after his baptism. It is a time of renewal and preparation for the joy of the resurrection feast of Easter.

During the month of **March** Emmanuel's will help the Bath Area Food Bank by collecting:


Pork & Beans, Baked Beans Any other Canned Beans

Why Do We Cover the Painting During Lent?


The painting above the pulpit is a rendering of the Ascension of Jesus, his moment of glory following the resurrection. During Lent we are called to focus on the cross and suffering of Jesus. To help us focus our attention on the cross, the picture is covered with a drape in the purple color of the season with a large cross placed in front of it. On Easter morning, part of the joy of the resurrection celebration will be the uncovered picture of Jesus on the way to the Father's Glory.

There are two separate sign-ups - one for the 8:45am Traditional Service and one for the 10:00am Celebration Service. The online addresses are long and cumbersome so the best way to access Sign Up Genius is by using the links that are listed in the weekly eNews or on our website (www.emmanuels.org).

If you don't have computer access or are uncomfortable using Sign Up Genius, please do not hesitate to call Lynne in the church office (610-837-1741) with your requests. She will be more than happy to take your information and enter it into the online system.

Just a reminder - as of January 1, 2022 whenever there are no "live" flower sponsors at either of the services, silk flower arrangements will be used in their place. If we have no sponsor at the contemporary service, a silk arrangement will be displayed. If there are no sponsors at all upstairs, two silk arrangements will be used at the altar. If we have a sponsor for one vase of live flowers upstairs on any given week, Emmanuel's will purchase the second live arrangement (which will provide matching flowers at the altar). The extra arrangement can be then delivered to a shut-in if appropriate. In recent years, we've had fewer flower sponsors, which in turn, means the church has been responsible for the added expense. So if you want to see "live" flowers on the altars please sponsor them!


